What does it mean to fish for people? **Read Matthew 28:19.**

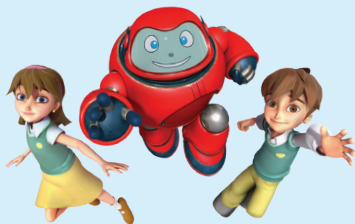
Who gives us the power to tell others about Jesus?
