TIME OUT

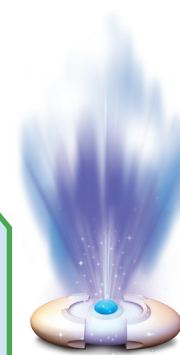
Sometimes, when children are disobedient, their parents may tell them to take a “time out” and sit in a quiet place where they can think about what they did wrong. Do you think that’s what God did to Jonah?

What did Jonah do while he was inside the big fish? We know exactly what Jonah prayed because it’s written in the Bible. [Read Jonah 2:1-7.](#)



Jonah ended his prayer by saying, *My salvation comes from the LORD alone* (verse 9). What do you think this means? What happened after Jonah prayed? [Read Jonah 2:10.](#)

PRAY: Dear God, thank You that I can pray anytime and anywhere, and that You hear and answer my prayers. Amen.



THE TURNAROUND

What happened when Jonah preached to the people of Nineveh? [Read Jonah 3:5.](#)

How does God feel about the people of the world? [Read 1 Timothy 2:4.](#)

What do you think “mercy” means? Read Ephesians 2:4-5. Jesus showed mercy to us by taking the punishment for our sins. How does He want us to treat others? [Read James 2:13.](#)

After Joy and the principal talked to the girl who stole the bike, how do you think she changed?
