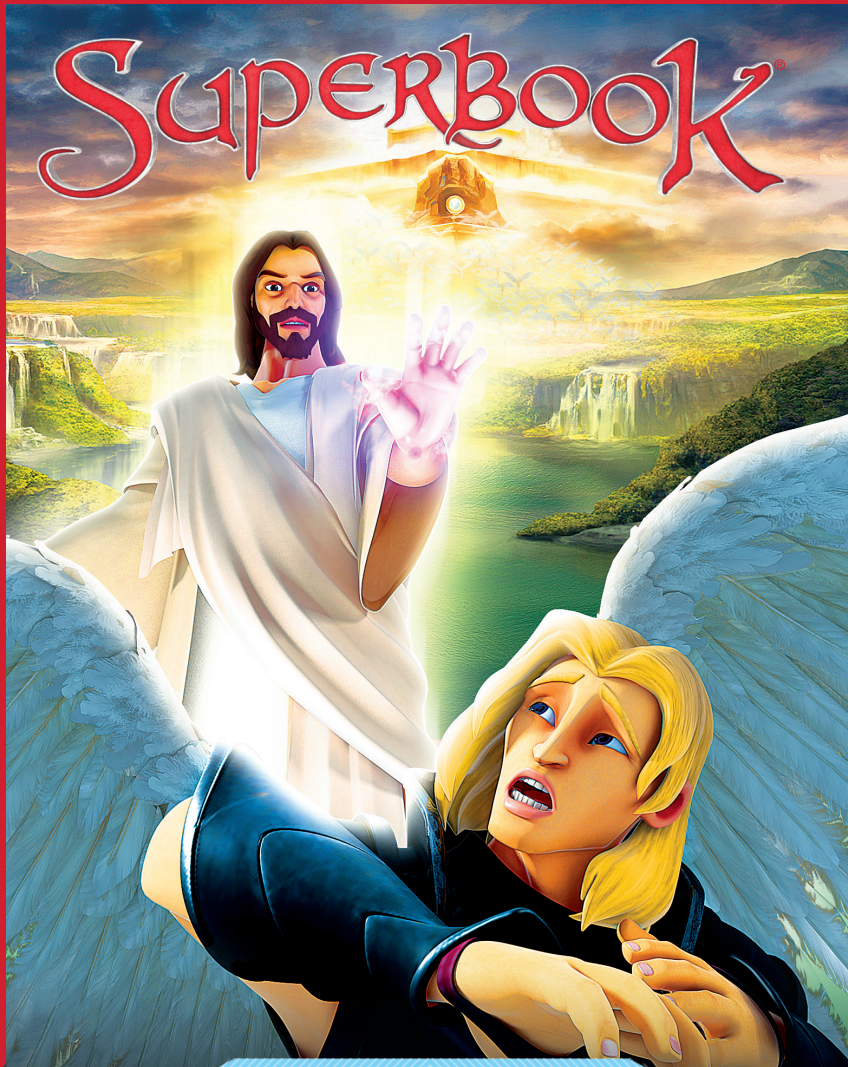

Have you ever thought you couldn't be forgiven? Did Satan tell Chris the truth when he said there is no forgiveness? John 8:44 says Satan *has always hated the truth.... He is a liar and the father of lies.* How does Satan want

us to feel when we do something wrong?

How is Jesus the opposite of Satan? **Read John 10:10.**

Why can we trust Jesus? **Read John 14:6.**

What should we do when we sin? **Read 1 John 1:9.**

The Apostle John was one of Jesus' closest friends and wrote five books of the Bible! Can you guess which ones? (The Gospel of John; three "epistles" or letters: 1, 2 & 3 John; and Revelation.)

PRAY

Dear Lord Jesus, thank You for loving me so much that You died on the cross to forgive my sins and take away my guilt and shame. Help me live for You. Amen.

THE BATTLE

Satan told Chris there was no one strong enough to protect him. What do you think is the truth? **Read Deuteronomy 31:6.**

Sometimes we must face difficult trials in life. Should we worry? **Read John 16:33.** What is Jesus doing for us right now? **Read Romans 8:34.**

John wrote about the great battle that will take place at the end of the world. Do we have anything to fear? **Read Revelation 12:10.**



PRAY

Dear God, I praise You that You are strong and wise and powerful! Thank You for being with me, no matter what problems I may face. Amen.

THE VICTORY

Tell about a time when you had to stand up for the Lord or do the right thing, even though it was very hard. What is our key to victory in the world? **Read 1 John 5:4-5.**



Do we need to be perfect before God will love us and help us? **Read Romans 5:8-9.**

Just before Jesus rose up to heaven, He told His followers how they can have power. **Read Acts 1:8.** What are some ways you can be a witness for the Lord?

Can you name three things that the Holy Spirit gives us? **Read 2 Timothy 1:7.**

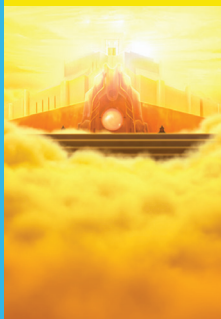
What should we remember if we feel alone or afraid? **Read 1 John 4:4.**

Lord Jesus, I place my faith in You. Thank You for sending the Holy Spirit to give me Your mighty power. Help me share the good news of Your victory with others! Amen.
